A month of Sundays

很長時間

a very long period of time

Example: It has been a month of Sundays since I last met my friends.

Five o'clock shadow

滿面鬍子

not having shaved for a day or two

使人愉快

to make you feel happy or satisfy you

Example: In the blink of an eye, our secondary school life has drawn to an end. It was just like yesterday when we were in kindergarten.

早晨的時候

very early in the morning, especially when the sun rises

Example: In order to catch the earliest train, we'll have to leave at the crack of dawn. So, wake up at 4 tomorrow morning.
