Put / Get your thinking cap on

認真思考 | to think in a serious way

Example: We need to figure out how to solve the problems before moving to the next step. Let's put our thinking caps on.

As easy as ABC

非常簡單 | very easy or simple

Example: The quiz is as easy as ABC. I don't understand why you have been struggling with it for so long.

Copycat

抄襲 | someone who copies another's work

Example: Don't mention our plan in front of Mandy. She is such a copycat! She will steal our ideas and use them as her own.

Hit the books

努力學習 | to study hard

Example: It is too late to hit the books just before the final examination. You should have studied hard in the beginning.

Tell tales out of school

說謊、散播謠言 | to tell lies or spread rumours

Example: I wish Matts would be honest to me and would not tell tales out of school. Sometimes, I find it hard to trust him even if he is telling the truth.

Pass with flying colours

獲得好成績 | to accomplish something very successfully

Example: My son passed his admission exams with flying colours. We are definitely going out to celebrate tonight.
