


Fun with English Idioms

More about "Learning"



1. DRAW A BLANK

沒有得到回應 / to get no response from others Example: The teacher asked John about the progress of the group project, but he just drew a blank. He did not seem to understand what the teacher was asking him about.

2. BOOKWORM

博覽群書的人 / someone who reads a lot Example: Pete is really a bookworm. Wherever he goes, he is reading all the time.

3. TEACH AN OLD DOG WITH NEW TRICKS

使守舊的人接受新事物 / to make someone change the way of thinking or doing things Example: I try my best to show my mother how to use the new app, but it is really hard to teach an old dog with new tricks.

4. TEACHER'S PET

最受老師喜愛的學生 / teacher's favourite student Example: Coco serves as Class Prefect and has performed the best in her leadership. For sure, she is the teacher's pet.

5. LEARN ONE'S LESSON

吸取教訓 / to understand something because of a bad experience

Example: I thought it was very easy to get good marks in an exam without making efforts, but since my last failure, I have learnt my lesson.

6. BRAINSTORM

想出新點子/to think of new ideas

Example: The teacher asked us to separate into groups, brainstorm and try to come up with as many new ideas as possible.
